

Phillip King Tennis Scholarship

Background:

Phillip King was a 1963 graduate of Lampasas High School. He started playing tennis in the sixth grade after having won a tennis racquet in a Lampasas Pet Parade. Although he was not a "stand-out" player in High School, he did show some early talents for the game, and he certainly enjoyed playing whenever he had the chance.

Mr. King continued his tennis-playing endeavors in college, and then played competitively in Houston, Texas for the next 45 years. Although Mr. King is currently retired from his career as a Certified Public Accountant, he still plays a rather solid game and tries to get on the courts at least 4 or 5 times a week.

Because of his long-time love for the game, the friends it has fostered, and fond memories of his days in Lampasas High School, he has generously created this scholarship fund to award two recipients each year who are graduating seniors from Lampasas High School that played Varsity level tennis.

Type:

- 1. Two scholarships (to one male and to one female) who are graduating seniors from Lampasas High School, Lampasas, Texas.
- 2. The male and female graduates must have participated at least one year at the varsity level of the Lampasas High School Tennis Team.
- 3. Those chosen to be recipients of this scholarship fund will be awarded scholarships towards their college expenses for their first year in college. Scholarship will be paid directly to higher institution.
- 4. The scholarship is non-renewable; i.e. scholarship will be awarded only once per recipient.

Amount: The amount of the scholarship is \$500 (five hundred dollars) per individual.
