# PHILLIP KING TENNIS SCHOLARSHIP FUND

## **APPLICATION FORM**

### BACKGROUND:

Phillip King was a 1963 graduate of Lampasas High School. He started playing tennis in the sixth grade after having won a tennis racquet in a Lampasas Pet Parade. Although he was not a "stand-out" player in High School, he did show some early talents for the game, and he certainly enjoyed playing whenever he had the chance.

Mr. King continued his tennis-playing endeavors in college, and then played competitively in Houston, Texas for the next 45 years. Although Mr. King has been retired since 2011 from his career as a Certified Public Accountant, he still plays a rather solid game and tries to get on the courts at least 3 or 4 times a week.

Because of his long-time love for the game, the many friends it has fostered, and fond memories of his days in Lampasas High School, he has generously created this scholarship fund to award two recipients each year who are graduating seniors from Lampasas High School that played Varsity level tennis.

#### **BASIC:**

- 1. Two scholarships (to one male and to one female) who are graduating seniors from Lampasas High School in Lampasas, Texas.
- 2. The male and female graduates must have participated at least one year at the Varsity level of the Lampasas High School Tennis Team.
- 3. Those chosen to be recipients of this Scholarship Fund will be awarded scholarships towards their college expenses for their first year in college.
- 4. The amount of the scholarship will be **<u>\$500.00</u>** (five hundred dollars) per individual.
- 5. The scholarship is non-renewable; i.e., scholarship will be awarded only once per recipient.

#### ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- 1. Male and Female applicants must be graduating Seniors from Lampasas High School.
- 2. The respective applicants must be intending to enroll in an accredited College or University in the next Fall Semester.
- 3. Applicants must have participated at the Varsity level of the Lampasas High School Tennis Team at least one year which includes their Senior Year.
- 4. Applicants must be graduating with grades at of at least B (or equivalent) average.
- 5. Applicants must fully complete all the submission requirements as described in the **Application Process** described on the following page.

#### APPLICATION PROCESS:

- 1. Complete the on-line *Lampasas High School Local Scholarship Application Form* in its entirety.
- 2. Complete the supplemental *Personal Essay (see Schedule A attached as an example)* which addresses the following <u>3</u> (*three*) key issues: (not more than 2 pages in total)
  - a. How they learned the sport of tennis.
  - b. What benefit the sport of tennis has provided to them individually.
  - c. How they believe the sport of tennis will impact upon their future.
- 3. Obtain 2 (two) short *Letters of Recommendation* (may be submitted directly to the Counselor's Office)
  - a. Academic (example: teacher, principal or counselor, or coach)
  - b. Personal (example: family friend, relative, employer, or other)
- 4. *High School Transcript*. (Current through at least first completed semester of senior year).
- 5. Submit all required documentation and applicant-signed and dated certification to:

- 6. Deadline to Apply: March 21, 2024.
- 7. Selection Committee will review all eligible applications. The Selection Committee will then notify scholarship recipients no later than <u>April 5, 2024</u>.
